## Sailors enters Hall today

Kenny Sailors, the man credited with developing the jump shot, the National Player of the Year at the University of Wyoming in 1943 and the oldest living Most Outstanding Player of the NCAA Tournament, is one of 10 individuals who will be inducted into the National Collegiate Basketball Hall of Fame today in Kansas City, Mo. Joining Sailors in the 2012 class of inductees are: Georgetown center Patrick Ewing; Kansas center Clyde Lovellette; North Carolina guard Phil Ford; Winston-Salem State guard Earl Monroe; Grambling center Willis Reed; Kentucky coach Joe B. Hall; Virginia Union coach Dave Robbins; and contributors Jim Host, founder of Host Communications; and Joe Dean, of Converse and LSU. The Hall of Fame Induction Awards Show will take place from 7 to 8:45 p.m. at the Midland Theater by AMC in downtown Kansas City, Mo. While the induction ceremonies are not televised live, ESPNU will televise the ceremonies on Dec. 9, beginning at 8 p.m.
